

School Employees Lorain County Credit Union YOUNG ADULT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Scholarship Committee of SELCCU's Board of Directors will determine the winners. Awards will be based on applicant's academic achievement, including his/her career objective, school activities, honors or awards, community activities, work and/or volunteer experience and a letter of recommendation.

Eligibility: Applicants must be members of School Employees Lorain County Credit Union, Inc. (SELCCU); between the ages of 17-25; and registered to attend any post-secondary educational institution full time (at least 12 credit hours) in fall 2019. Eligible institutions include universities, colleges, technical schools, trade and vocational institutions. The applicant must be an active member of School Employees Lorain County Credit Union, Inc.

This program may award up to six (6) non-renewable scholarships of \$1,000 each, including the Warren Wallace Education Major Scholarship. Up to three (3) scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors and up to three (3) scholarships will be awarded to students currently enrolled as a full time student at any post-secondary educational institution. SELCCU reserves the right to revise, suspend or discontinue this program without notice.

To apply:

1. Make sure you have a SELCCU account in your name before February 28, 2019.
2. Complete the application form. **Please type or use a pen.**
3. Attach an official transcript from your high school or college.
High school seniors only: please include your SAT or ACT score(s).
4. Attach a letter of recommendation.
5. **High school seniors only:** Attach a letter of acceptance from college, university or training program if available.
6. Applications must be received no later than **February 28, 2019**.
